ILC Special Classes at Junior High Schools



Special ILC classes are being held at junior high schools across Ichinoseki. On July 16, an online class was held at Genbi Junior High School, with Junpei Fujimoto of the Institute of Particle and Nuclear Studies, High Energy Accelerator Research Organization (KEK) as the lecturer. The lesson touched on the universe being made of elementary particles and through the cloud chamber experiment where the tracks of particles that are normally invisible can be observed, students learned of the importance of experiments as well as the purpose of the ILC. .
