## Kids Science 2022

On August 6, 24 primary school students from Ichinoseki and Hiraizumi attended the hands-on science class 'Kids Science 2022' held and sponsored by the South Iwate Research Center of Technology. Students worked on a robot that can walk on two legs without using batteries or a computer with Professor Akihiro Suzuki as a lecturer. The students continuously challenged themselves to aim for stable bipedal walking when designing the robot's center of gravity and walking breadth.
